Westbrook House, Upperton

Refurbishment and minor alterations, demolition of garage, reinstatement of Victorian greenhouse, minor landscape works.

After a discussion it was unanimously agreed that the Clerk comment as follows:

The concept of what is proposed is not objected to by the Parish Council. However, Councillors are concerned about the traffic and noise implications in an already difficult area, where there have been incidents of large lorries damaging properties and vehicles.

Permission should include tight conditions as to how access should be delivered. Consideration should be given to trying to gain access from New Road through the land that goes with the property.
